HEAT RECLAIM: BENEFITS, SYSTEM EXAMPLES, AND MISAPPLICATIONS

Buildings are responsible for 40% of the total U.S.A primary

energy consumption; and 43% of the energy consumed in commercial buildings is used for space and water heating. If a more efficient means of providing

heat could be implemented, it would represent a tremendous

TO IMPROVE SYSTEM EFFICIENCIES opportunity to reduce energy



consumption in buildings. In response to an energy crisis and an oil embargo, the 1970's was a decade during which design engineers recovered heat from the chiller's condenser for use in other portions of the building or process. As energy costs have again increased, and environmental awareness has come to the industry forefront, use of energy recovery has again increased.

In applications from hotels to hospitals, casinos or universities, for service water heating to building heating, pool heating or preheating domestic water sources, heat recovery is not only possilbe but also potentially a very efficient means to reduce energy costs and consumption. (
